With few exceptions, this catalog has been assembled the same way the old SKin GRAFT comic books Drawing (or in a lot of cases, re-drawing) those album and cd covers struck me as a lot more appealing than sitting hour after hour at the helm of the Adobe Photoshop this summer.

How does a band like Minneapolis' COLOSSAMITE fit into the scheme of things happening in music today? They don't. They ignore convention and do things their own way- with a collective mind set of ingenuity and integrity. On Economy Of Motion, Colossamite has ripened. The writing was completed just days before entering the studio, some of the lyrics were composed hours before the first take. Nobody really knew HOW it was going to turn out...! It has an edgy, spontaneous feel. The vocals are eerily near. The guitars duel with and respond to one another. There's no explaining what time signatures Chad is playing in: his cymbal crashes just HANG there, and by the time the smoke clears, the band is heading down a lorked road that didn't even exist two seconds ago. Reactions from those privy to the advance tape, have ranged from 'horrifying' to 'heartfell' to 'hilarious'. It's got a soothing, paranold, nervous, scratchy, jazz-rock (in a

very literal sense), gut wrenching feel to it. "Economy of Motion" is a compilation/mix tape gone awry. The ingredients have blended into a rare encounter - music that is strident and honeyed, built of unorthodox twists and turns, but also wholly memorable and absolutely lasting. Colossamite is the meeting ground of hardcore, "noise", sophisticated improvisation-- and so much more. This, folks, is the hereafter... post-jezz-hardcore stew, indeed.
